Swimming Safety Reminders!

Here are a few points from our Agency Standard on Swimming and Water Safety. Be sure to check out the full standard on the Staff Portal.

- CS supports can only take individuals swimming in areas when there is a Certified Lifeguard on active duty. (Some gyms do not have certified lifeguards on duty so be sure to check!)
- Prior to swimming, each individual must have a swimming plan that includes a swim assessment performed by a certified lifeguard or written parent information regarding swimming abilities, as well as written levels of supervision in the water and other health and safety parameters identified. Be sure to check with your supervisor before going swimming with an individual you are working with!
- CSP must be in the water at all times with the individual for whom they are responsible.
- CSP must be within arm's length when near a shoreline, dock or boat.
